### First Aid Mini Kit

Containing:	
Triangular Bandage	The First Aid Kit should be kept in a Waterproof Container and should only be opened if required after consultation with a Patrol Leader or Scout Leader.
Sterile Dressings	
Table Salt	
Small Pair of Scissors	
Tweezers	
Safety Pins	
Coins for the Phone	
Card with your Personal Details on it.	

**Notes:** Plastic bags are for putting soiled clothing in. It is a good idea to line your rucsac with a strong bin liner as this will protect your kit from getting damp.

It is a good idea that when you turn up for an activity you should have a hat and a drink with you to help protect you from dehydration - hence reason for a plastic water bottle being in the kit list.

When travelling to and from camp, **Full Uniform** is to be worn. As your uniform will be needed during the camp, it needs to be kept smart, so please bring a **coathanger** on which your uniform shirt, scarf and school trousers can be hung and kept crease free.

**Check off the item when you pack your kit and check it off again when you unpack your rucsac after you get home.**
