

# SCOUT ASSOCIATION - ISLE OF MAN T.T. RACES 2017

## Information for Cubs, Scouts, Explorer Scouts, Leaders & Parents.

- Minimum age for attendance is 10 Years (*Insurance requirement*).
- The 2017 T.T. Races are being held on Saturday 3. June (*arrive 09:30*), Monday 5. June (*arrive 09:15*), Wednesday 7. June (*arrive 09:15*) and Friday 9. June (*arrive 08:45*). Race Times can be found here: <http://www.iomtt.com/TT-Info/Qualifying-and-Race-Schedule.aspx>.
- Everyone who applies to help on the Scoreboards **must** be able to commit to all four race days. However due to over subscription, some members may be asked to attend for just two race days.
- Cubs, Scouts, Explorer Scouts and Leaders are asked to arrive at the Grandstand at the times shown above.
- Due to adverse weather conditions, the Races may have to be held on alternative days to those above. Race Starts may also be delayed due to the weather.
- Please listen to Manx Radio (*Radio TT*) for up to date information on postponements and delays. Any changes will also be notified using Social Media, email, etc.
- Cubs, Scouts and Explorer Scouts, should be dropped off at the rear of the Grandstand and not on the main road fronting the Scoreboards. Meeting place is to the rear of the Control Tower.
- Everyone who attends and is under the age of 18, must bring a fully completed **Parental Agreement Form** together with a fully completed **Contact and Medical Information Form**, which can be downloaded from [www.manxscouts.com](http://www.manxscouts.com).
- Everyone should ensure they give their name to the person taking the register on each day of their attendance.
- Cubs, Scouts and Explorer Scouts can be collected from the rear of the Grandstand, below the Control Tower, once the days racing has finished. Listen to Manx Radio for any delayed finish times. Any changes will also be notified using Social Media, email, etc, when possible.
- Cubs, Scouts, Explorer Scouts and Leaders must wear uniform. Only those in smart full uniform, including shoes will be selected to go on the winner's podium to hold a flag.
- Everyone should bring a coat (*with their name in it please*).
- Lunch and refreshments are provided by the organisers, but please bring a filled plastic water bottle for additional refreshment. Fussy eaters may wish to bring their own lunch.
- Only those who are able to attend each day they are asked to attend will be awarded the 2017 T.T. Badge, which can be worn on the back of the Scarf for one year only.
